**NOTICE OF HEARING**

**THE INVESTIGATION COMMITTEE OF THE ONTARIO COLLEGE OF TEACHERS**, pursuant to section 26, subsection (5) of the *Ontario College of Teachers Act, 1996* (the "*Act*"), Statutes of Ontario, 1996, chapter 12, has directed that the matter hereinafter described regarding the conduct or actions of Cameron G. Walker, Certificate No. 707887, be referred to the Discipline Committee of the Ontario College of Teachers.

**IT IS ALLEGED** that Cameron G. Walker is guilty of professional misconduct as defined in the *Act* in that:

- (a) she abused a student or students psychologically or emotionally, contrary to Ontario Regulation 437/97, subsection 1(7.2);
- (b) she committed acts that, having regard to all the circumstances, would reasonably be regarded by members as disgraceful, dishonourable or unprofessional, contrary to Ontario Regulation 437/97, subsection 1(18);
- (c) she engaged in conduct unbecoming a member, contrary to Ontario Regulation 437/97, subsection 1(19).

**PARTICULARS OF THESE ALLEGATIONS ARE AS FOLLOWS:**

1. Cameron G. Walker (the “Member”) is a member of the Ontario College of Teachers (the “College”).
2. In or about the 2021-2022 academic year, the Member was employed by the Kawartha Pine Ridge District School Board (the “Board”) as an occasional teacher on assignment at [XXX] School (the “School”) in Peterborough, Ontario.
3. In or about the 2021-2022 and 2022-2023 academic years, Student 1 was a male student at the School in Grades [XXX] and [XXX] respectively.
4. Between in or about April 2022 and in or about September 2022, the Member engaged in a personal relationship with Student 1 that crossed appropriate teacher-student boundaries. Student 1 was under 18 years old during this time period.
5. Between in or about April 2022 and in or about May 2022, the Member sent text messages to Student 1 that were inappropriate in nature, including but not limited to one or more of the following messages or words to their effect:
  - (a) responding with a heart emoji to text messages she received from Student 1, including a text message that stated “I love you”;
  - (b) stating in a text message to Student 1, “please text when you’re safe at your house” and when Student 1 texted that he was home, the Member responded, “dooood why are you so late”;
  - (c) stating in a text message to Student 1, “you are literally my favourite brother for life no matter what rocky roads we have to travel i will always protect you before myself and i will love you always. I hope you never forget this”; and

- (d) exchanging text messages with Student 1 about giving Student 1 money for “munchies” and/or about giving them “one last hug”.
6. Between in or about April 2022 and in or about September 2022, the Member purchased items for Student 1 and/or gave Student 1 items, including but not limited to one or more of the following items:
- (a) one or more pairs of shoes;
  - (b) a cell phone;
  - (c) a cell phone plan;
  - (d) food from a food delivery service;
  - (e) money; and
  - (f) AirPods.
7. Between in or about April 2022 and in or about September 2022, the Member offered to Student 1 and/or Student 1’s mother to purchase items and/or services for Student 1, including but not limited to a new computer and/or mental health services.
8. On or about September 9, 2022 and/or on or about September 12, 2022, the Member asked Student 1’s mother not to share with the Board and/or the College, information regarding the Member’s relationship with Student 1, including but not limited to screenshots of text messages between the Member and Student 1.
9. In or about October 2022, on one occasion during the evening, the Member was in a vehicle with Student 1.

**THE DISCIPLINE COMMITTEE WILL HOLD A HEARING** pursuant to sections 30, 32 and 32.1 of the *Act* to decide whether the allegations are true and whether Cameron G. Walker is guilty of professional misconduct. A copy of the *Rules of Procedure of the Discipline Committee and of the Fitness to Practise Committee* (the “*Rules of Procedure*”) will be provided upon request and is also available on the College’s website.

**THE DISCIPLINE COMMITTEE WILL HEAR THIS MATTER** on a date to be determined after consultation between College Counsel and you or your counsel and fixed by the Tribunals’ Office.

**YOU ARE ENTITLED TO BE PRESENT AT THE HEARING AND TO BE REPRESENTED BY LEGAL COUNSEL.** The hearing will be held electronically using audio or video conferencing equipment, pursuant to the *Rules of Procedure* and the *Statutory Powers Procedure Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.S.22 (the “*SPPA*”).

**IF YOU DO NOT ATTEND ON THE SCHEDULED HEARING DATE, THE DISCIPLINE COMMITTEE MAY PROCEED WITH THE HEARING IN YOUR ABSENCE AND YOU WILL NOT BE PROVIDED WITH ANY FURTHER NOTICE OF PROCEEDINGS.**

**IF YOU BELIEVE THAT AN ELECTRONIC HEARING OR ELECTRONIC SET DATE HEARING IS LIKELY TO CAUSE YOU SIGNIFICANT PREJUDICE**, you must notify the Tribunals’ Office at 101 Bloor Street West, Toronto, Ontario, M5S 0A1. The Discipline Committee will then determine whether the hearing will proceed in person, electronically, in writing, or by a combination of these formats.

**IF A DATE FOR THE HEARING AND/OR THE FORMAT OF THE HEARING ARE NOT AGREED UPON, THE DISCIPLINE COMMITTEE WILL CONVENE TO DEAL WITH THE PROCEDURAL MATTER OF SETTING A DATE AND/OR ESTABLISHING THE FORMAT FOR THE HEARING.** The procedural hearing will be held electronically using audio or video conferencing equipment, pursuant to the *Rules of Procedure* and the *SPPA*.

**YOU ARE ENTITLED TO BE PRESENT WHEN THE COMMITTEE CONVENES TO SET A DATE AND/OR FORMAT FOR THE HEARING AND TO BE REPRESENTED BY LEGAL COUNSEL. IF YOU DO NOT ATTEND BEFORE THE COMMITTEE TO SET A DATE AND/OR FORMAT FOR THE HEARING, THE DISCIPLINE COMMITTEE MAY PROCEED IN YOUR ABSENCE TO SET THE DATE AND/OR FORMAT. NOTICE OF THE HEARING DATE AND/OR FORMAT SET BY THE COMMITTEE WILL BE PROVIDED TO YOU IN WRITING AT YOUR LAST KNOWN EMAIL ADDRESS AS SHOWN IN THE RECORDS OF THE COLLEGE.**

**IF THE DISCIPLINE COMMITTEE FINDS YOU GUILTY** of professional misconduct, you are liable to the penalties set out in section 30 of the *Act*.

**A MEMBER** whose conduct is being investigated in proceedings before the Discipline Committee may examine before the hearing any written or documentary evidence that will be produced or any report, the contents of which will be given as evidence at the hearing.
