Subject: Report of the Registration Appeals Committee

Committee Meeting and Panel Dates

Since its last report to Council, the Registration Appeals Committee met on May 22, May 23, June 13, July 11 and August 21, 2019.

Summary of Discussions

Meeting

On May 22, 2019, the Committee reviewed and approved the 2020 Committee budget as well as reviewed the ongoing training schedule. On July 11 the Committee received the Committee's 2018 Statistics Report. At the August 21 meeting the Committee received additional training on Academic and Professional Suitability certification requirements.

Panel

The Committee met as a panel five times to consider a total of eleven cases and rendered a decision in all cases.

Five of the eleven cases were in French. Three cases included an oral presentation. The outcomes for these appeals are as follows:
